Deacons? Who are they? Actually, Deacons are ordained officers of our church who serve a three-year voluntary assignment. The ministry of the Deacons falls into three major areas: personal interaction with members by specific area assignment, special mission funds administration, and worship assistance.

They keep in contact with church members in their respective areas with cards, notes, phone calls, and visits for special occasions and when you have personal needs. They administer a benevolence fund to help provide financial help to church members and people in the local community who are dealing with personal hardships. You will also see Deacons hosting on Sunday mornings and serving communion on Communion Sunday in church and in homes of members unable to attend.
