A LETTER FROM JERICO

Dear Parents,

It feels like a long way from now, but Summer 2019 is coming. We are so excited to bring another group of kids up to Hume Lake next summer. I hope you consider sending your 3rd thru 5th grade student to Summer Camp.

We will be going to Hume Lake Christian Camp the week of Sunday, July 7th to Saturday, July 13th. We are letting you know way in advance so you can plan what your summer looks like.

Wagon Train is the section of the camp for elementary grade kids (3rd thru 6th Grade). Your student can be a camper if your student is entering 3rd grade to 5th grade in the Fall 2019.

The **cost of camp is \$550**. We are asking for a \$100 deposit with sign ups. The rest of the camp balance can be paid over time. Scholarships are available in two forms:

- 1) Church scholarship
- 2) Campership

Scholarships depend on when funds are available. Campership is a program sponsored by Hume where independent donors sponsor kids to go to camp. If this is something you would be interested in, please indicate that on the sign-up sheet and I will relay the necessary information to you as it becomes available.

There is a separate form for scholarships.

Lastly, we only have 10 spots for Wagon Train, please sign your student up as space is limited. If we need more spots, we may request and be put on a waitlist.

I am so excited to bring another group of kids to Hume Lake Wagon Train and see how God can use camp to grow a deeper relationship with your student. If you have any questions, don't hesitate to email me at jalmiranez@cpchb.org.

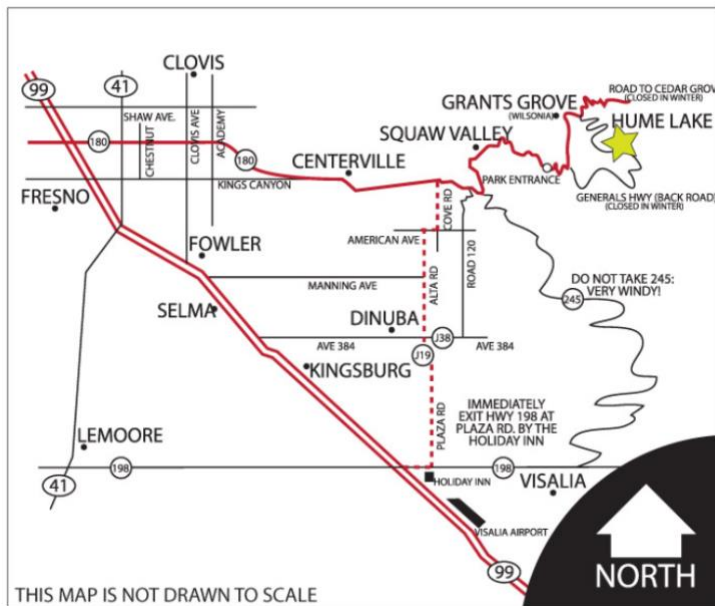

Directions to Camp

From Southern California

- Interstate 405, I-5, to CA-99.
- Head North on CA-99 for 96.6 mi
 - Merge onto CA-198 East
- Exit immediately on Plaza Dr. (Exit #102)
 - Turn left (north) on Plaza Dr.
- Plaza becomes Rd80/Alta Ave—Continue North
 - Turn Right (east) at E American Ave
 - Go 2.5 miles
 - Turn left (North) at Cove AVE
 - Turn right (East) at CA-180
 - Veer Right at Hume Lake Rd
 - Stay to the right
- Welcome to Hume Lake Christian Camps

Note: Most online mapping services will suggest you take the 245. It is a curvy, winding road that will take you at least an additional hour. DO NOT TAKE 245.

SUMMER REGISTRATION PROCEDURES AND POLICIES.

Deposits & Payment

A \$100 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit must accompany the Summer Camp Registration Form. The total cost of summer camp is **\$550**.

Payments may be made on a payment schedule to help with budgets and provide flexibility for individual families, but is not mandatory.

Refund Policy

The \$100 deposit is to reserve your space and is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Scholarship Policy

Scholarships may be requested and dependent upon availability of fund. Each student can be awarded up to 20% of the total cost of camp. Scholarship is available for families who register early. Scholarship forms are available on the website. This form is due on January 28, 2019.

Forms Needed

Summer Camp Registration Form (online, Christ Pacific Church Parent Release Form are required.) Hume Lake Consent and Release of Liability Form are also required (this is an online form provided by Hume approximately 3 weeks before camp).



Sleeping Arrangements

Students and their counselors will be sleeping in covered wagons. There will be a girls' wagon and a boys wagon. Each bed has a personal shelf. There are 4 large areas underneath the wagons for extra storage.



Care Packages: If you wish to send a care package, please bring them to the Christ Pacific Church office the week before camp. We will give them to the kids on Wednesday during the middle of the week. Some campers might feel home-sick and getting a package gives them extra encouragement for the week. Please make sure to label the package with their name.

Departure: Students must arrive at the church parking lot for check-in by 7 am on Sunday July 7th. Please have your student(s) mark ALL their luggage and personal items with their name prior to check-in.

Return: Students will arrive back at the church around 5 pm Saturday July 14th. If we are delayed or unexpectedly early, parents will be notified at the contact number specified on the Summer Camp Registration Form.



Money: The question always comes up, "How much money should I send with my student?". We recommend between \$10-\$20 for the lunch on the drive up to Hume and lunch for drive on the way home. But while at camp, kids do not need to bring physical money.

Trading Post takes place every day between 2 to 5pm. Campers can buy snacks or crafts. In Wagon Train, parents can just deposit money into their account. Thursdays, the camp partners with a mission organization and kids are asked if they'd like to donate money to missions; and sometimes kids give money from their accounts. Please talk with your student about this.

What to pack

Bedding: Sleeping bag, pillow, twin bed sheet, alarm clock (battery powered)

Clothing: Pants, shorts, swim shorts/swimsuit (one piece), sweatshirt (hooded), t-shirts, dark/camo clothing for night game, shoes – regular use, shoes-to get wet, socks-bring extra, sandals-for pool and shower times, underclothes, hat

Toiletries: Towel/Beach towel, soap/shampoo, personal hygiene

Other: Bible, pen/paper, flashlight, batteries, sunscreen, Chapstick, bug spray, camera and batteries, water bottle, decorating supplies for wagon.



What NOT to pack: Electronic Devices (mp3 players, gaming consoles/cell phone), fireworks, firearms, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, knives, pets, water balloons.
